Play area proposal
Cairnhill play area is a natural play area designed primarily for 8-12 year olds and built predominantly out of materials found locally. Rather than using standard play equipment, the park provides a range of different play environments that encourage children to use their imaginations and interact with the environment as they choose.

There are places to be active - to run, climb and swing - and places to be calm - to sit, chat or hide. The park will open in the summer of 2021 but the concept for the park is that it is a dynamic play space that is periodically refreshed, depending on how it is used. New additions will be announced as the park evolves over the years to come.
